We wish to remind visitors to exercise caution around high flowing water, especially as flows on some parts of the system are well above seasonal norms. All boaters are also reminded to watch their wake as these can be dangerous and damaging to property along the canal, and reduce their speed accordingly.

Parks Canada thanks the public for their patience and cooperation at this time while our team continues its hard work to manage water on the system as levels stabilize after an unprecedented amount of precipitation.
